## Policies and Classifications for Fitness Center Membership

- A **RESIDENT** is anyone who resides in the city of South Milwaukee, WI 53172.
- A **NON-RESIDENT** resides outside the city limits of South Milwaukee, WI 53172.
- A **HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT** is one who attends high school – students must present a valid student ID for enrollment. All South Milwaukee High School Students are considered residents. All High School Students who attend schools other than South Milwaukee will be considered resident or non-residents depending upon where they live. *(Middle School Students are not eligible for an individual membership).*
- A **SINGLE MEMBERSHIP** is an individual, one person.
- A **FAMILY MEMBERSHIP** includes oneself, spouse, and children through the age 21. Middle school aged children will be admitted under the family plan if accompanied by an adult. All members listed on the application must reside in the same household.
- A **SENIOR** is an individual 55 years or older.
- A **SENIOR COUPLE** is two seniors jointly filing taxes and/or married.
- A **STAFF MEMBERSHIP** includes those individuals currently employed full or part-time with the School District of South Milwaukee. A minimum of 20 hours a week must be worked to be eligible for this type of membership.
- A **CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP** is a group of at least 5 individuals who work full, or part-time in a particular business or corporation.
- A **GUEST** will be allowed to accompany a member after registering and paying the designated guest fee. A member may bring only one guest into the facility. Guests are not allowed access to the North Court/Gymnasium.
- **TRACK ACCESS** will be available to all residents at no cost after a one-time \$5 membership card fee. Non-residents will be allowed to use the track if they pay the assigned non-resident user fee.
- Only card-carrying members will be allowed access to the facility unless a guest pass is issued.

Suspension of Memberships—A membership can be deemed suspended or revoked for any cause of conduct which is deemed inappropriate by school staff.

Firedrills—Being within a high school does require periodic testing of evacuation procedures. We will do our best to inform members of these drills prior to testing.

Community Locker rooms—Doors are locked during school day. Entry keys are available by security personal at entrance hallway.
