

Policies and Classifications for South Milwaukee Fitness Center Membership

- A **RESIDENT** is anyone who resides in the city of South Milwaukee, WI 53172.
- **PAYMENT**—electronic payment with a credit or debit card is required on month to month memberships. Your membership will automatically renew unless a written “request to cancel form” is turned in a week prior to your expiration date. These forms are available at the fitness center desk or online.
- **HOLDING** a membership. A membership can be put on hold for a maximum of 12 months. Extension of expiration dates due to illness need approval from fitness center manager
- A **NON-RESIDENT** resides outside the city limits of South Milwaukee, WI 53172.
- A **HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT** is one who attends South Milwaukee High School – students must present a valid student ID during enrollment. All South Milwaukee High School Students are considered residents. All Students who attend schools other than South Milwaukee will be considered non-residents. (*Middle School Students are not eligible for an individual membership*).
- A **SINGLE MEMBERSHIP** is an individual, one person over 18 years of age.
- A **FAMILY MEMBERSHIP** includes oneself, spouse and children through the age 24. Middle school aged children will be admitted under the family plan if accompanied by an adult. All members listed on the application must reside in the same household.
- A **SENIOR** is an individual 55 years or older.
- A **SENIOR COUPLE** is two seniors jointly filing taxes and/or married / one must be over 55.
- A **STAFF MEMBERSHIP** includes those individuals currently employed full or part-time with the School District of South Milwaukee. A minimum of 20 hours a week must be worked to be eligible for this type of membership.
- A **CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP** is a group of at least 5 individuals who work full, or part-time in a particular business or corporation.
- A **GUEST** will be allowed to accompany a member after registering and paying the designated guest fee. A member may bring only one guest into the facility.
- **TRACK ACCESS** will be available to all residents at no cost. However, residents wishing a track access card printed in the fitness center will be charged the designated card fee. Non-residents will be allowed to use the track if they pay the assigned non-resident user fee.
- Only card-carrying members will be allowed access to the facility unless a guest pass is issued.

Suspension of Memberships—A membership can be deemed suspended or revoked for any cause of conduct which is deemed inappropriate by school staff. Shoes should always be worn in facility.

Firedrills—Being within a high school does require periodic testing of evacuation procedures. We do our best to inform members of these drills prior to testing

Community locker rooms—Doors are locked during school day. Keys available by security personal at entrance hallway.

College Student Benefits—All students seeking these rates must show active ID.
